Accurately use capital letters and full stops.

Include conjunctions.

Use exclamation marks appropriately.

Focus on the presentation of their writing with an emphasis on handwriting.

Continue to have daily spelling, guided reading, and punctuation and grammar sessions.

<u>As Mathematicians...</u>

The children will:

Learn to tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes.

Explore mass, capacity and measure.

Tackle tricky one and two-part word problems all about minibeasts.

Continue to practise calculations and learn to use estimation effectively.

Continue to work on measures, shape and money.

Revise the units we have covered so far, with particular emphasis on calculations $(+, -, x, \div)$.
